I am very pleased to confirm that the 55th European Bridge Team Championships will be held at

Casino Da Madeira & Savoy Hotel 17th to 27th June 2020

Format of the Championships

The Team Championships consist of 4 Series: Open, Women, Seniors and Mixed.

All 4 Championships will be played as a single complete round robin. The number of boards played in each match will be determined and published when the number of participants is known. The Open Championship will be played over 11 days, and the Women's, Seniors' and Mixed Championships will be played over 7 days.

Right to enter

Each member NBO is authorised to enter one team in the Open Series, one team in the Women's Series, one team in the Seniors' Series and one team in the Mixed Series of the Championships. NBOs must have paid the entry fee and be in good standing including payment of 2020 dues to the EBL.

Each participating NBO must play against all other participating NBOs. Entry and subsequent refusal to play will result in disqualification.

Competitor's Commitment form

Attention is drawn to Article 2.8 of the EBL GCoC. Players, Captains, Coaches and other Team Officials in Teams Championships, who have not already submitted one, are required to have signed the EBL Competitor's Commitment Form (see GCoC Appendix 2) before the start of the event.

Entry Fees

The entry fees are \notin 3,500 for the Open and \notin 2,500 for the Women, Seniors and Mixed Teams. A discount will be given to NBOs that did not participate in that particular Series in any of the last two EBL Bridge National Teams Championships held in Budapest 2016 and Ostend 2018: for these teams the entry fees are \notin 1,750 for the Open and \notin 1,250 for the Women & Seniors Teams.

In addition to the above, any NBO sending teams to all four Series will receive an additional 10% discount.

<u>Note</u>: Any players requiring exemption certificates should ensure that the Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE) Application Form is fully completed, together with the necessary supporting documents (see what is required at <u>www.wada-ama.org/en/science-medical</u>) and return it to the address given on the document as soon as possible and **no later than 30 days before the commencement of the competition in which you are participating**. It is acceptable to scan and email the TUE form and documentation.
